Borealis Pinot Noir (OR) <i>Flavors of pie cherry and wild strawberry with a savory quality that subtly permeates the fruit.</i>	16
B & G Pinot Noir Bistro (FR) <i>Purple red color, aromas of red cherry fruits with spicy hints, tobacco, coffee notes, cherry pie and vanilla flavors</i>	13
Sterling, Cabernet Sauvignon (CA) <i>Lush notes of blackberry, cherry, black current, vanilla</i>	13
Botromagno Nero di Troia, Super Tuscan (IT) <i>Fruity notes of cherries, vanilla, smooth and full bodied</i>	16
Portillo, Malbec (AR) <i>Deep hues of ruby red gain intensity from shades of shimmering violet in this Malbec with good structure, medium acidity and a long finish. Rich with fruit, the nose is reminiscent of plums and blackberries.</i>	12

White Wine

Chardonnay grape makes consistently excellent, rich, and complex whites. Chardonnay offers bold, ripe, rich and intense fruit flavors of apple, fig, melon, pear, peach, pineapple, lemon and grapefruit, along with spice, honey, butter, butterscotch and hazelnut flavors.

Barbera grape, produced mainly in Piedmont, creates dry, light-or medium bodied wines with intense berry flavors.

Cabernet Sauvignon produces wines of great intensity and depth of flavor. Its classic flavors are currant, plum, black cherry and spice. It can also be marked by herb, olive, mint, tobacco, cedar and anise, and ripe, Jamy notes.

Red Wine

Malbec, intense red violet color. It has a character of dark red fruits and a hint of plum on the palate, the wine is fruity and smooth with fresh acidity and firm with approachable tannins.

Pinot Noir, the great grape of burgundy, is a touchy variety. The best examples offer the classic black cherry, spice, raspberry and currant flavors, and an aroma that can resemble wilted roses, along with earth, tar, herb, and cola notes.
